

### ASSOCIATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROFESSIONALS CHANNEL COUNTIES CHAPTER NED ROGOWAY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Channel Counties Chapter of the Association of Environmental Professionals (AEP) is dedicated to supporting students who are pursuing a career in the environmental field. As part of our support endeavors, we are offering three \$500 scholarships to undergraduate and graduate students attending Cal Poly - San Luis Obispo. Scholarships associated with our 2024 scholarship program will be awarded on or before June 1, 2024. All awardees will be invited and encouraged to attend the Natural Resources Management & Environmental Sciences Department Spring Banquet and a Channel Counties Chapter of AEP Board virtual meeting to receive recognition and celebrate their achievement.

## WHO CAN APPLY & AWARD CRITERIA

The Channel Counties Chapter of AEP will accept applications from Cal Poly undergraduates or graduate students who are actively engaged in the pursuit of a career with an environmental emphasis. One \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student in the Environmental Management and Protection Major within the Natural Resources Management & Environmental Sciences Department. The other two \$500 scholarships are open to all Cal Poly students who aspire to pursue a career in the environmental field. <u>Applicants must be planning to return to Cal Poly for the 2024 Fall or Summer Academic Term in order to be eligible.</u>

Award criteria include overall GPA (no minimum requirement), academic pursuits, relative financial need, content, flow, and enthusiasm of the personal essay, grammar, spelling, and formatting of the personal essay, and demonstrated involvement in the environmental field. A copy of college transcripts (unofficial or official) and maximum two-page essay are also required along with a completed application form.

## HOW CAN THE MONEY BE USED?

The award can be used for any aspect of education, including tuition, books, housing, research, etc.
